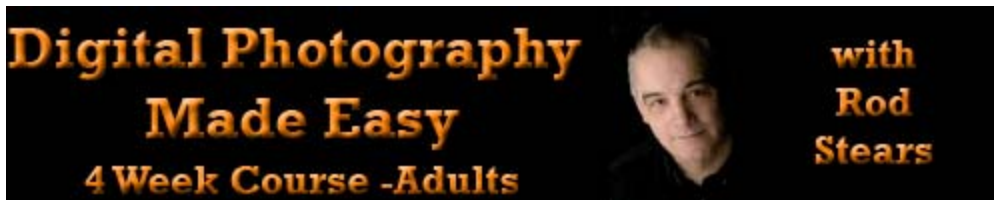

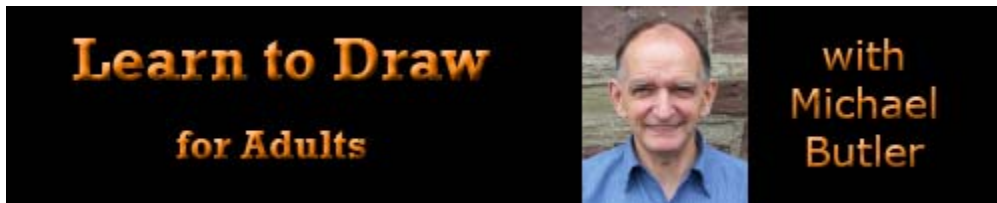
transfer to computer, image storage, built in flash);
